



## Elliot Noel Serrano

December 11, 1944 - January 2, 2013

Elliot Noel Serrano-Tirado, 68, of 1013 Maple Street, Lebanon died Wednesday January 2, 2013 in the Good Samaritan Hospital, Lebanon. He was the husband of Joanne M. Cessna Serrano. Born in San Juan, Puerto Rico on December 11, 1944, he was the son of the late Santiago and Josefa Tirado Serrano. He was retired as a Staff Sgt. from the US Army after 25 years of service and later joined the US Army Reserves with the 121st Transportation Unit. He did two tours, one in Vietnam and one in Operation Desert Storm. He also worked as a custodian at Ft. Indiantown Gap. Elliot enjoyed all auto racing, was a lifetime member of the Lebanon V.F.W. Post 23 and several other community organizations. Surviving in addition to his wife is a step-son Anthony Cessna of Shamokin, a brother Edwin Serrano of Florida, a sister Gloria of Philadelphia, a nephew Tony Santiago of Philadelphia, and several cousins, nephews, and nieces. Funeral services will be held on Friday January 11, 2013 in the Kreamer Funeral Home and Crematory at 1:30 PM. Interment will be in Indiantown Gap National Cemetery with Full Military Honors.
