Elmer T. Beck, 81, of Lebanon, passed away on Tuesday, July 24, 2018 at his residence. He was the husband of Nancy M. (Umberger) Beck, with whom he would have celebrated 29 years of marriage on August 5th.

Elmer was born in Lebanon County on November 26, 1936 to the late Boyd H. Beck Sr., and Elizabeth (LeGay) Beck. Elmer was a 1955 graduate of Lebanon High School. He had worked 45 years for Sterling Packaging in Lebanon as a six color pressman. He was a member of St. Matthew's Lutheran Church, where he was very involved. He was on church council, men's group, choir, an usher, on the music and worship committee, helped with fundraising, and enjoyed greeting everyone at church. Elmer was a Past Master of Mt. Lebanon Lodge # 226 F.&A.M. He was also a member of the Harrisburg Consistory, Lebanon County Shrine Club, Zembo Shrine, York Rite Bodies, and Lebanon Chapter #115 order of the Eastern Star.
