Emory G. Meyerhoffer, 74, of Grantville, passed away on Sunday, July 23, 2023, at his home.

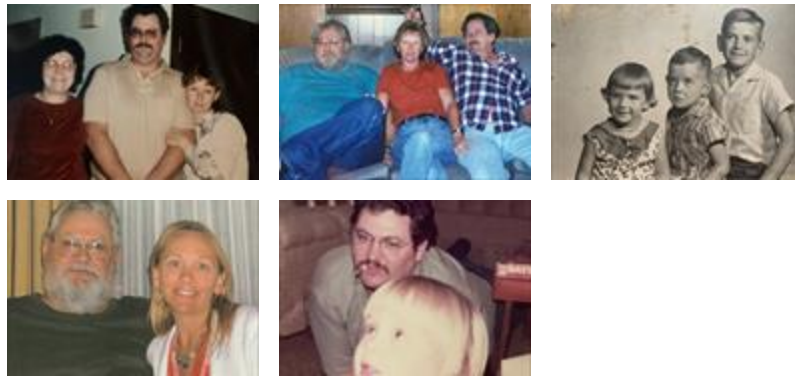

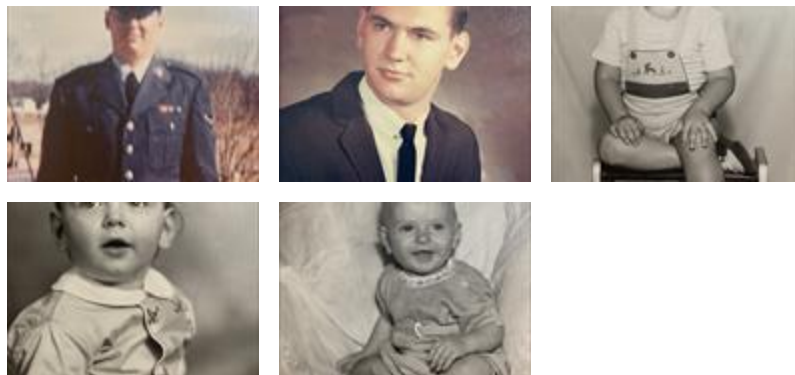
