Esther A. Kline, 91, of 500 E. Queen Street, Cottage #1, Annville died Monday February 14, 2011 in the Lebanon Valley Home, Annville. She was the wife of the late Mark C. Kline who died in 1993 after 53 years of marriage. Born in Lebanon on November 11, 1919, she was the daughter of the late Grant L. and Bertha M. Shuey Soliday.
