



## Evelyn M. Fitzpatrick

March 6, 1922 - November 29, 2012

Evelyn Fitzpatrick, age 90, of Lebanon, died Thursday November 29, 2012. She was born March 6, 1922 in Bethlehem, PA, to Willis and Carrie Bernhard. She is survived by her sons James, (wife Diane) Pottsville, PA and Kevin, (wife Mary) Fayetteville, AR, six grandchildren, two great-grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews. After graduating from Myerstown high school in 1940, she began working in Harrisburg for the Pennsylvania State Tax Bureau. She worked there for several years and in 1944 met William Fitzpatrick who was in the Marines stationed in Mechanicsburg, PA. They celebrated their 66th wedding anniversary on December 6, 2011. After marrying and moving to Myerstown, PA, William eventually began working for his father-in-law who was the proprietor of W.E. Bernhard Excavating and Evelyn would remain the bookkeeper for that company. Both William and she would retire in 1978. After retirement, they enjoyed traveling all over the world managing to visit six of the seven continents. They spent many winters with great friends in Hawaii, Arizona, and Florida. After spending more than 50 years at their address on 30 Berbec Avenue in South Lebanon they moved out to Cornwall Manor. Evelyn was a member of Saint James Lutheran Church where she enjoyed singing in the choir, and occasionally playing piano in a pinch. She was active in scouting where she served as a den mother of Pack 45 for several years and continued that interest in helping out with scouting and Troop 45.
