



## Evelyn L. Isele

December 5, 1918 - April 17, 2016

Evelyn L. Isele, 97, of Jonestown, passed away on Sunday, April 17, 2016, at the WellSpan Good Samaritan Hospital, Lebanon. Born in Jonestown on December 5, 1918, she was the daughter of the late L. David and Annie Lentz Isele. Evelyn retired in 1981, from the State Turnpike Commission where she had worked in the Records Dept. She was a member of the Jonestown United Methodist Church and had also attended the St. John's United Church of Christ, Jonestown. Evelyn was a 1937 graduate of the Jonestown High School and was a member of the Order of the Eastern Star for over 66 years. She served as a Girl Scout Leader, Member of the Ladies Auxiliary and had been the Jonestown Tennis Champion. During World War II, she worked as a Plane Identifier at night. She loved history and was known as the Jonestown Historian. She was the Author of 5 books; Jonestown Pennsylvania 1761-1961, Jonestown High School 1915-1958, One Hundred Years of History The Church Home 1881-1981, 140 Years of Smiles JBT 1873-2013, and Did You Know?, A Collection of Articles About the History of Jonestown, Pennsylvania area. She is survived by Cousins Todd ,Lena ,Breanna, Serena and Zachary Donmoyer of Jonestown, Steven Donmoyer of Jonestown, Walter Donmoyer of Frenchville, Marsha Spitler of Jonestown , Raymond Kulp and Family of Lebanon, and several others.
