Francis L. "Babe" Bensinger, 86, of N. Lebanon Twp., passed away on Friday, October 12, 2018, at the WellSpan Good Samaritan Hospital. He was the husband of the late Mary E. Bennett Bensinger.

Born in Tremont on November 26, 1931, he was the son of the late Francis W. and Mae C. Kissinger Bensinger.
