



Frank L. Heilman Sr.

Frank L. Heilman, Sr., 89, of Lebanon passed away on Saturday, September 14th, 2024, at the WellSpan Good Samaritan Hospital. He is survived by his loving wife, Joan H. (Ney) Heilman.

Born in North Annville Township on October 17th, 1934, he was the son of the late Russel F. and Helen V. (Miller) Heilman. Frank began working at Donough Pharmacy in downtown Lebanon as a Pharmacist in 1957. He became the proprietor of the business in 1982 and retired in 2015. He was active in the Center of Lebanon Association, and the Lebanon Valley Chamber of Commerce. In 2012, Frank was named as the Community of Lebanon Association Man of the Year. He was an avid collector of vintage Fisher-Price toys and HO model trains.

Surviving in addition to his wife is a son, Frank L. Heilman, Jr. of Palmyra, and a sister, Rachel Hoffman of Annville. Frank was preceded in death by three siblings, David Heilman, Russell Heilman, and Vivian Tucker.
