Franklin Delano Roosevelt Bohr, 87, of Jonestown, passed away on Sunday, November 29, 2020, at the StoneRidge Towne Centre, Myerstown. He was the husband of the late Lugret K. Kohr Bohr.

Born in Pine Grove on April 9, 1933, he was the son of the late Samuel E. and Sarah E. Eby Bohr. He worked as a crane and forklift operator at Bethlehem Steel and retired in 1986.
