Frederick O. Seltzer died Thursday, December 13, 2012, in the M.S. Hershey Medical Center. He is survived by wife, Linda Shover Seltzer, daughter Rebekah Seltzer-Idgunji, son-in-law Dev Idgunji, granddaughter Katherine Elizabeth Idgunji, and soon to be grandson Samuel Frederick Idgunji. He is also survived by a brother James Seltzer as well as many devoted and loving relatives, friends, and neighbors. He was preceded in death by his brother Robert Seltzer. Fred was born in Annville on November 18, 1941, the son of the late Marlin L. and Helen Longenecker Seltzer. He was a 1959 graduate of Annville-Cleona High School and a 1963 graduate of Elizabethtown College. He received his master's degree in Education and Administration from Temple University and his Reading Specialist /Supervisory certification from Millersville University. He was a retired Educator and Administrator for the Cornwall-Lebanon School District. Fred was the Lebanon County High School Athlete of the Year and the Elizabethtown College Senior Athlete of the Year. He was an All-American Division III soccer player. He was inducted into Elizabethtown College Hall of Fame for soccer and baseball in 1980 and inducted as a team Hall of Fame member in 2000. Fred was a Lebanon County Education Honor Society member. He was a member of Mt. Gretna United Methodist Church and served on the Mt. Gretna Sewer and Water Authority. Memorial services will be held on Friday, December 28, 2012, at 11 a.m. at the Mt.
