



## Frederick T. Schultz

Frederick T. Schultz, 76, of Newmanstown, formerly of Mechanicsville passed away on Friday April 5, 2024, at the Lebanon VA Medical Center. He was the husband of Nancy L. (Haley) Schultz. On May 3, 2024, they would have celebrated their 55th Wedding Anniversary.

Frederick was born in Pottsville on June 3, 1947, to the late Frederick and Elsie (Durr) Schultz, Mechanicsville. He was a graduate of Nativity BVM High School Class of 1965. Following high school, Frederick served as a U. S. Marine in the Vietnam Conflict. Frederick worked as a Correction Officer first at the Schuylkill County Prison, Pottsville.
