Gary S. "Hutch" Hutchinson, 71, of Lebanon, passed away on Sunday, January 11, 2026, at Hershey Medical Center. He was the husband of Luanne (Reese) Hutchinson, with whom he celebrated three years of marriage. Gary was born in Allentown, PA, on April 27, 1954, to the late Lawrence and Marion (Fabian) Hutchinson. He was a graduate of Bloomsburg University.
