November 21, 1951 - March 16, 2025

George A. Eash, 73, of Fredericksburg, passed away peacefully at his home surrounded by his loving family on Sunday, March 16, 2025. He fought a courageous fight. He was the husband of Debra E. (Eisenhour) Eash. On June 6th, they would have celebrated their 35th wedding anniversary.

Born in Johnstown on November 21, 1951, he was the son of the late Merle Sr., and Thelma (Blough) Eash. He served in the U.S. Marines during the Vietnam Conflict. George was the former owner of Eash's Towing & Salvage in Fredericksburg and a local racecar driver. He was well known in his community, and he was loved by many for his kind heart and his willingness to help anyone.
