



George E. Patton, Jr.

April 6, 1931 - April 17, 2018

George E. Patton, Jr., 87, of Lebanon died Tuesday, April 17, 2018 in his residence. He was the husband of Lorraine Kreider Patton with whom he celebrated their 63rd wedding anniversary this past February.

Born in Lebanon on April 6, 1931, he was the son of the late George E., Sr. and Celia Boltz Patton. He was a 1949 graduate of Lebanon High School, a 1953 graduate of Lafayette College with a degree in Industrial Engineering. He was commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant in ROTC and raised to Captain in the National Guard where he served for 6 years from 1956-1962. He was also a U.S. Army Veteran of Korea.

George had quite an extensive employment history. He had worked at Calcite Quarry for 18 years and served as its president, at Kurtz Brothers (High Industries) and Lancaster Lime and Stone he served as president for 10 years, served as vice-president of Sheridan Corporation of 4 years, employed for 2 years at Faddis Concrete, CEO of Lebanon County Builders Association for 1 year, and was one of the founders and executive director for 5 years for the Pennsylvania Concrete and Masonry Association.

George was very active in his community and held numerous offices for the Lebanon Water and Sewer Authority for 30 years, member and president in 1967 of the Lebanon Kiwanis Club, the Lebanon Jaycees, 50-year member of the Steitz Club, Free and Accepted Mason Lodge #226, Zembo Temple Shrine, and Lebanon BPOE Elks #631. He served on the Board of Directors of Lebanon County Trust, Lebanon Valley Chamber of Commerce, Quality Inn,

and Oakview Nursing Home.

He was a long-time active member of St. Mark's United Church of Christ, Lebanon where he served on the Consistory, Building Committee, as a Deacon, and Sunday School Teacher.

Theater was a life-long passion for George and he took frequent trips to NYC and Broadway of which he has an extensive collection of Theater programs and participated in the local community theater.

Surviving in addition to his wife are two daughters Kay Patton Snyder wife of Larry, Anita Patton O'Connor wife of Maurice, three grandchildren Philip Snyder, Sarah and Hayley O'Connor, and a brother William L. Patton and wife Sharon. He was preceded in death by a grandson David Snyder.

Funeral Services will be held on Thursday, April 26, 2018 at 2:30 PM at the Kreamer Funeral Home and Crematory, 618 E. Main Street, Annville. A viewing will be held at the funeral home from 1:30-2:30 PM. Interment will be held at the convenience of the family in Cornwall Cemetery.
