Glenn A. Quintana, Sr., of Penns Creek, and formerly of South Bethlehem, NY passed away on Wednesday, November 29, 2017, at his home. He was the husband of MaryLu Twining Quintana. On August 16th, they celebrated their 65th wedding anniversary.
