Griffith A. Weik, 95, of Lebanon died Tuesday, June 20, 2017 in Cedar Haven Nursing Home, Lebanon. He was the husband of Lula E. Shartle Weik with whom he would have celebrated their 66th wedding anniversary this August.

Born in Lebanon on February 26, 1922, he was the son of the late Harry P. and Dorothy Hoffman Weik. He was a retired machine operator at Bethlehem Steel, Lebanon.

Griff was a U.S. Air Corp. veteran of WW II having served as a B-17 pilot with the 483rd Bomb group taking part in over 35 missions.

He was a 1941 graduate of Lebanon High School and was a member of the football team. He was a member of Christ Presbyterian Church, Lebanon where he served on the Board of Trustees and helped take care of the Church grounds. Griff enjoyed classical music, nature, and taking long walks.
