Harold John "Barnie" Barnhart, Jr., 76, of Jonestown, passed away on Wednesday, November 25, 2015, at the Lebanon VA Medical Center. He was the husband of Gail A. Moyer Barnhart. On August 3rd, they celebrated their 52nd wedding anniversary. Born in Palmyra on March 5, 1939, he was the son of the late Harold J. and Hilda P. Barnhart. He retired in 2001 from Yellow Freight, where he had worked as a mechanic. He had also worked for Manheim's Raybestos Manhatten Inc., and for 12 years he had worked for C.P.Long in Lickdale.
