Harry ("Lee") Schrum, Jr., 84, passed away on Friday, November 27th after a recent diagnosis of cancer.

He was born on December 12th, and raised in Youngstown, Ohio. Due to a company transfer, he and his family moved to Pennsylvania in 1983. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army, a laborer, and in his retirement was a carrier for the Patriot News. Lee was a kind and loving man who would "give you the shirt off his back" if you needed one. He was a member of Mt. Lebanon Lodge #226 and the Lebanon York Rite Bodies.

He married the love of his life, Donna Jeanne ("DJ") (Wellendorf) on August 17, 1963 and they recently celebrated their 57th wedding anniversary. He was also an amazing father to his children Deb (Mark) Lerchen, Keith (Carin) Schrum, and Brian (Lisa) Schrum, and was also known to "adopt" many of his children's friends as though they were his own.
