Harry D. Wilt, 87, of 150 Hearthstone Lane, Lebanon formerly of Cleona died Wednesday September 18, 2013 in Stoneridge Town Center, Myerstown. He was the husband of the late Clara M. Reese Wilt who died in 2006.

Born in Harrisburg on January 22, 1926, he was the son of the late Harry R. and Ruth A. Porter Wilt. He was retired from the accounting department at the Mechanicsburg Naval Depot.

Harry was US Army Veteran of WW II serving under General George Patton at the Battle of the Bulge and was awarded the Purple Heart.
