Henry J. "Hank" Martin, Jr., 82, of Lebanon, passed away on Monday, February 24, 2020 at WellSpan Good Samaritan Hospital. He was the husband of D. Elaine (Shuey) Martin, with whom he just celebrated 65 years in marriage this February 12.

Hank was born in Lebanon on June 23, 1937 to the late Henry J. Martin, Sr. and Elona E. (Demler) Martin. 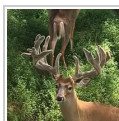
