Henry Wengert Miller, 89 formerly of 350 Cumberland Street, Annville died Friday October 2, 2009 in the Lebanon Valley Home, Annville. He was the husband of Lois J. Stump Miller with whom he would have celebrated their 64th Wedding Anniversary this December. Born in Fredericksburg on July 31, 1920, he was the son of the late Raymond C. and Sara E.
