



Henry P. Steckbeck

Henry P. Steckbeck, 79, of Lebanon died Sunday June 1, 2014 from a variety of ailments including cancer and heart failure. He was the husband of the late Jane Heverling Steckbeck who died in 2000.

Born in Lebanon on May 13, 1935, he was the son of the late James and Miriam Romig Steckbeck. He retired from Lebanon Building Supply as General Manager after 41 years of service where he made many friends with the local builders and contractors, and was commonly known as “Henry the Fence Man”.

Henry was a 1953 graduate of Lebanon High School, and a member of the Lebanon County Builders Association, ACE, Friendship Fire Company where he served as a firefighter for 23 years, treasurer of Lebanon Boy Scout Troop 45, and the Neversink Fire Company where he managed the Social Club and served as its president for 17 years. He was one of eleven children and is survived by one brother Samuel Steckbeck of Harrisburg.
