Jack H. Miller, 84, of 622 S. 14th Avenue, Lebanon died Tuesday April 10, 2012 in the Lebanon VA Medical Center. He was the husband of Betty B. Lauer Miller to whom he was married 61 years. Born in Lebanon on March 7, 1928, he was the son of the late George Miller and the late Elva Harvey Miller Sharp.
