James L. Bowers, 84, of 34 N. King St., Annville died Monday, April 27, 2015 at the Harrisburg Hospital. He was the husband of the late Janet M. Binkley Bowers who died in 2002.

Born in Marietta on November 15, 1930, he was the son of the late George and Nellie Zink Bowers. He was a grounds keeper for Grand View Memorial Park and Indiantown Gap National Cemetery. He also worked part-time after retirement for Annville Township.

Jim proudly served his country with the U.S. Marine Corp. during the Korean War. He was a member of St. Luke's Episcopal Church, Lebanon where he served as an usher and was active with the Senior Men's Group. He was also a member and recording secretary of the Annville Union Hose Fire Company, active with the Annville Ambulance Association, Annville American Legion Post 559, Lebanon Detachment Marine Corp. League, Boy Scouts of America Order of the Arrow, and an officer with the Hershey Chocolatiers Drum and Bugle Corp. He was also a volunteer with voter registration for Annville West, an 18 year volunteer at the Hershey Medical Center Emergency Room, and was one of the original organizers of the Annville Memorial Day Parade.

Surviving are sons James C. Bowers, Sr. and wife Helen of Lebanon and Terry L. Bowers and wife Kathy of York, six grandchildren and six great

grandchildren, and a very special friend Ken Binkley. He was the last of his immediate family and preceded in death by five brothers and one sister.

Funeral services will be held on Friday at 11AM at the Kreamer Funeral Home & Crematory 618 E. Main St. Annville. Interment with military honors will be in the Mt. Annville Cemetery. Viewing will be held from 9-11AM prior to the service at the funeral home.
