James "Jim" Unger, 84, of Annville, died Wednesday, May 2, 2018 at the Lebanon VA Medical Center. He was the husband of Esther (Foltz) Unger, to whom he would have been married 66 years this October.

Born in Philipsburg, PA on July 1, 1933, he was the son of the late Edward J. and Evelyn (Hicks) Unger. Jim graduated from Annville High School with the class of 1951. He was a veteran of the US Army, worked as a clerk for the US Government and later worked part time at LVC as a visiting team greeter. Jim was a member of Christ Church U.C.C.
