James W. Stokes, 86, of Jonestown, passed away on Thursday, July 23, 2020, at his home. He was the husband of Laura D. Kyler Stokes. On November the 21st, they would have celebrated their 65th wedding anniversary.

Born in Harrisburg on February 24, 1934, he was the son of the late James E. and Martha Richter Stokes. James retired from the Dept. of Justice in the District of Columbia, where he was the Supervisor over FBI printing. He was a member of the Perry F & AM Lodge 458 in Marysville for over 50 years, where he was a 32nd degree Mason. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, Philadelphia sports, and Penn State basketball and football. He also served in the U.S. Army following the Korean Conflict.
