Jean M. Kindt, 77, of Jonestown, passed away on August 19, 2017 at the Penn State Hershey Medical Center. She and her husband Kenneth A. Kindt would have celebrated their 56th wedding anniversary on August 26.

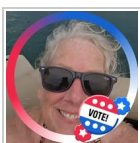
