Jeffrey David Brandt, 70, of Lebanon, passed away after a courageous battle with cancer on Friday, May 15, 2026, at Hospice & Community Care in Mount Joy. He was the husband of Martha J. (Snyder) Brandt. They celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary in August of 2025.

Jeff was born in Lancaster on April 2, 1956, to Arthur and Mary (Rettew) Brandt. He graduated from Penn Manor High School in 1974. Jeff served in the U.S. Navy for six years.
