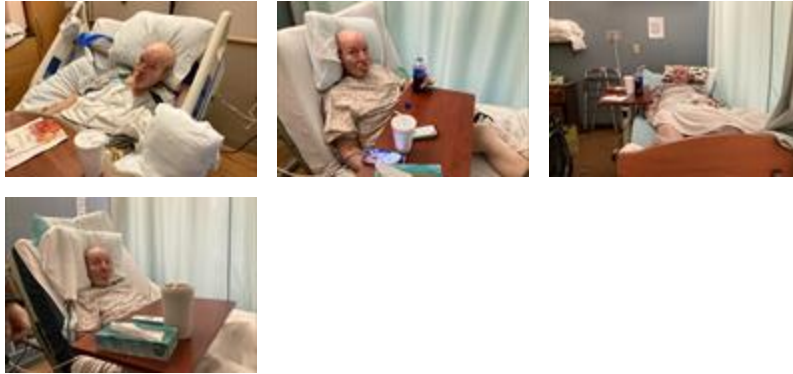
Surviving in addition to his significant other are five siblings, and a niece, Caroline Eby. He was preceded in death by a brother.
