Joseph A. Barnhart, 77, of Lebanon passed away on Monday, January 2, 2023, at WellSpan York Hospital. He was the husband of Mia (Taniguchi) Barnhart. They celebrated their 49th wedding anniversary this past December. Born in Lebanon on September 1, 1945, he was the son of the late George and Ethel (Boyer) Barnhart. Joseph served his country in the Navy during the Vietnam Conflict; he continued in the Navy and retired after 20 years of service supporting Naval Intelligence. He had a love of fishing, travel, and automobiles. He was also a passionate follower of Philadelphia Phillies baseball and Japanese sumo wrestling.
