Joseph S. Meily, 83, of Lebanon, passed away on Monday, September 9, 2019, at his home after a courageous battle with cancer. He was the husband of Margaret L. "Peggy" Troop Meily. On June 1st, they celebrated their 62nd wedding anniversary.
