Judith "Judy" L. Ditzler, 73, of Annville, passed away peacefully surrounded by her loving family, while holding her husband's and daughter's hand, on Tuesday May 23, 2017 at ManorCare in Lebanon. She was the wife of Rodney L. Ditzler, with whom she celebrated 49 years in marriage. Judy was born in Lebanon on June 13, 1943 to the late Roger and Arnetta (Hunsicker) Grimes. She was a graduate of Cornwall High School, Goldey-Beacom College and a member of Palm Lutheran Church in Palmyra. Throughout her life, she has held various job positions. After college graduation, she had worked in Governor Bill Scranton's office in the administrative staff. She was standing with Governor Bill Scranton when they received the news that President Kennedy had been assassinated. She had worked for Bethlehem Steel as a data entry supervisor, and in sales at Hershey Chocolate World. Judy had a favorite job title, and that was a stay at home mom. Judy had the ability to light up a room with her smile and had many friends who loved her dynamic and uplifting attitude and personality. She had been the chairperson and took charge of a fundraiser in Palmyra. She helped to raise money for a family to save their home who had lost their basement to the first sink hole in Palmyra. She had a love for animals and never met an animal she didn't love. She was a caregiver for a feral cat community in a Trap Neuter Release (TNR) program with support from the The Dog's Den. Judy enjoyed traveling, camping, knitting, was avid tennis player, piano player and enjoyed spending time with her family. Surviving in addition to her husband is a daughter Amy

and husband Jeff Heffner of Palmyra, grandchildren Arnetta and Owen, and a brother Roger Grimes Jr., and his wife Valerie of Lebanon. Memorial services will be held on Tuesday May 30, 2017 at 11AM at Palm Lutheran Church, 11 W. Cherry Street, Palmyra. Interment will be private.
