



## June Elizabeth Reinbold

June Elizabeth Reinbold, 94, of Lebanon died Tuesday, November 29, 2016 in Elmcroft. She was the wife of John D. Reinbold to who she was married 70 years.

Born in Washington, DC on June 21, 1922, she grew up in Virginia and was the daughter of the late George and Alpha Kessler Rieley.

June graduated as the valedictorian from Mt. Vernon High School, Virginia in 1940 and then from Philadelphia General Hospital School of Nursing in 1943. She then entered the U.S. Army Nursing Corps on January 27, 1944 and was discharged as a Captain on November 13, 1947. June then worked at the Lebanon VA Hospital after WW II following her discharge from the U.S. Army.

She was a member of St. James Lutheran Church, Lebanon, Lebanon Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star, and the Blockley Nurses Club in Philadelphia. June was the founder of the Nightingale Organization and a former member of the American Red Cross.

Surviving in addition to her husband are two sons John D. Reinbold, Jr. of Mt. Wolfe, Thomas K. husband of Dawn Reinbold of Lebanon, and five grandchildren.
