Karl B. Brandt, 85, of Annville died Tuesday April 12, 2011 in his residence. He was the husband of the late Betty (Henry) Brandt and the late Joanne (Brandt) Brandt. Born in Lebanon on July 30, 1925 he was the son of the late Hiram Light and Elizabeth Bainbridge Brandt. Karl was a carpenter crater for 15 years with the Middletown Army Depot and later worked as head foreman with the New Cumberland Post Engineers Department for 14 years. He was a WWII veteran serving in the US Navy. He was assigned to the Denebola Ad-12 Destroyer tender as a deckhand, first class and later served on the DD 474 Fullam as a coxswain boatman. Karl was a 32nd degree mason serving 53 years with the Harrisburg Consistory, a member of the Mt. Lebanon Lodge #226, F&AM and was a cedar with the Quittapahilla Forest #25. He is survived by three sons Bret A. Brandt and wife Fran of Annville, Randy H. Brandt of Hershey and Bruce A. Brandt and wife Suzanne of Lebanon; two step-sons Randall Herrington and wife Ann and Kevin Herrington and wife Linda both of Palmyra; three step-daughters Karen wife of Rodney Bowman of Palmyra, Susan wife of Michael Snyder of Annville and Paula wife of Tom Schramm of Elizabethtown; 17 grandchildren and 18 great-grandchildren.
