March 10, 1933 - July 25, 2008

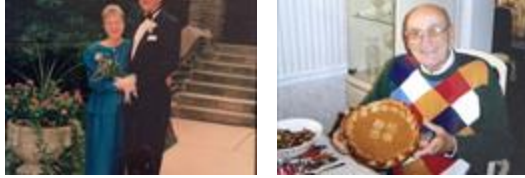
