Kenneth R. Kilmoyer, 94, formerly of Lebanon, died Sunday, May 21, 2017 in the Lebanon Valley Home, Annville. He was the husband of Janette I. Cortright Kilmoyer who died in 2014.

Born in W. Lebanon on February 19, 1923, he was the son of the late John B. and Hannah Daubert Kilmoyer. He served as Branch Manager of Reading Foundry and Supply Company, Lebanon for 40 years. During WW II, he worked at the New Cumberland Army Depot helping to repair and rebuild aircraft engines.

Ken was a 1940 graduate of Lebanon High School, a member of St. Mark's United Church of Christ, Lebanon, where he served on the Consistory as an Elder and Deacon, Mt. Lebanon Lodge #226, F.& .A. M., Harrisburg Consistory, Zembo Temple Shrine, and a lifetime member of the Friendship Fire Company. He was a longtime volunteer for the American Cancer Society and also an avid bowler, golfer, Phillies, and Eagles fan.
