Kenneth Oliver Queen, 85, of Annville, passed away on Thursday, January 13, 2022, at his home surrounded by his family and friends. He was the husband of Eloise R. Seltzer Queen. On November 28th, they celebrated their 57th wedding anniversary.

Born in Mt. Pleasant, Westmoreland County, on November 6, 1936, he was the son of the late Oliver P. and Mary McQuillis Queen. He attended and graduated from the Greensburg Salem H.S. Class of 1956. Following graduation, he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force. After leaving the Air Force, he worked as a project manager for Adam Elden Miller Construction Co. When he married and moved to Annville, he worked for Hershey Foods as their senior Construction Specialist in the Corporate Engineering Dept., and he retired after 34 years of employment. He attended the Zion E.C. Church in Annville and was a former member of the Bunker Hill E.C. Church. He enjoyed playing softball, bowling, golfing, and riding in a plane. He especially loved the Steelers and having breakfast on Tuesday morning with the gang. In addition to his wife, he is survived by brother Ralph (Barb) Janis of Greensburg, PA; several nieces and nephews; and his special niece Tina Weaber, who supported and cared for her uncle during his journey with cancer.
