Kenneth E. Parks, 80, of Palmyra died Wednesday April 4, 2012 in Select Specialty of the Holy Spirit Hospital, Camp Hill. He was the husband of Ann Clements Parks to whom he was married 56 years. Born in Charleroi, PA on July 1, 1931, he was the son of the late William E. and Garnet McCallister Parks. He was a retired math teacher from the Annville-Cleona School District for 30 years.
