Larry Lee Evans, a dedicated and loving husband, father, grandfather, brother, and friend to many, passed away on Friday, July 31, 2020 at WellSpan York Hospital. He was the husband of Carol J. (Blantz) Evans, with whom he celebrated 51 years in marriage.

Larry, 76, a resident of Lebanon, was born in Palmyra on April 3, 1944 to the late Russell and Mabel (Lam) Evans. Larry was a 1962 Palmyra High School graduate.
