Laura M. Anspach, 90, formerly of Grantville died Saturday, January 14, 2017 in the Royer House at the Lebanon Valley Brethren Home, Palmyra. She was the wife of the late John H. Anspach who died in 1990.

Born in Harrisburg/Progress on December 22, 1926, she was the daughter of the late Joseph Garfield and Anna Johns Witmer . Along with her husband, she was the owner and vice president of Anspach Auto's, Grantville which they started in 1950. She also managed a number of family business' including real estate, a radio station, and Brek Mar Cinder Company.

Laura was a 1945 graduate of Jonestown High School, a member of Emmanuel United Methodist Church, Memorial Lake where she served as a Church Trustee, Sunday School Teacher, Youth Fellowship Advisor, and was the Building Fund Treasurer for over 40 years. She was also a member and President of the East Hanover Twp. PTA, Kindred Place Red Hat Society, East Hanover Golden 50's, and President of the Jonestown High School Alumni Association. She was the first women and first Democrat to be elected as Judge of Elections in East Hanover Twp. in the 1960's.

Surviving is a daughter Jeanne wife of James A. Earnshaw of Lebanon, two sons Edward L. Anspach and companion Audrey Cassady of Hershey , Joseph A. and wife Diana Barto Anspach of Grantville, grandchildren

Benjamin husband of Korissa Earnshaw, Timothy Earnshaw, Trevor husband of Amanda Anspach, Mallory Anspach, and great grandchildren Noah, Hannah, and Laura. She was also one of thirteen children and is still survived by a brother David Witmer of Hershey , and two sisters Naomi Deaven of Ono, and JoAnn Zinn of Venice, Florida.
