Lee Roy Keaton, 55, of Grantville, passed away on Thursday June 16, 2022 in Rehoboth Beach, DE. He was the husband of Elizabeth A. (Wentling) Keaton, with whom she celebrated 30 years in marriage.

Lee was born in Lebanon on July 2, 1966 to Roy Lee and Karen (Rhoad) Keaton, of Hummelstown. He obtained his associate degree from HACC.
