Leon O. Dailey, 96, of Lebanon County died on March 19, 2026. He was married to Caroline (Reese) Dailey for 74 years. In addition to his wife, he is survived by son Robert L. Dailey (Shirley) of Cleona, and daughters Sharon K. Davis (Buddy – deceased) of Snow Hill, North Carolina, Susan C. Dailey of Lebanon, and Lisa A. Swarr (Kevin) of Millersville.
