Linford C. "Lin" Donmoyer of Lebanon passed away on Monday, May 18, 2020, at the WellSpan Good Samaritan Hospital. He was the husband of Mary Desante Donmoyer. On May 31, 2020, they would have celebrated their 17th wedding anniversary.

Born in Green Point on December 4, 1939, he was the son of the late Woodrow and Rachel Kreiser Donmoyer. He served in the U.S. Army. He then retired from Alcoa, where he had been an Industrial Electrician. Lin was a member of the Mt. Zion Fire Co., where he had served as the Fire Chief, Captain and Treasurer.
