Lois J. Arnold, 79, of Lebanon, passed away on Sunday, January 17, 2021. She was the wife of Rev. Barry J. Arnold. On October 5th, they celebrated their 57th wedding anniversary.

Born in Lancaster on February 26, 1941, she was the daughter of the late Lester R. and Martha S. Snyder Hess. For many years, Lois had worked as a nurse at Cornwall Manor and the former United Christian Church Home. She was a member of the Lebanon God's Missionary Church and was very active at the church while her husband served as the senior pastor. For many years she was a Sunday School teacher, conducted Vacation Bible Schools, and was the church pianist. She was always an encourager and mentor to mothers and women in need of love and counsel. She was a "grandma" to many of the children in the church and was known to have a purse full of goodies and toys.
