Luke T. Wagner, 73, of Lebanon, went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, February 10, 2018, at the WellSpan Good Samaritan Hospital.

Born in Lebanon on June 16, 1944, he was the son of the late Harold and Pearl Stamm Wagner. He graduated from South Lebanon High School. Luke worked at the Dixie Drive-In, Atkins Barn in Jonestown, and Bethlehem Steel. He was a member of the God's Missionary Church and an active member of the Lebanon Gospel Center, where he served for many years as the song leader, treasurer, board member and groundskeeper. Luke will be remembered for his kindness and generous spirit. He was always the first to volunteer to help wherever he was needed. He was vital in the running of Canaan Grove Camp Meeting. Luke enjoyed hiking the Rail Trail, Middle Creek Wildlife Preserve, and in Mt. Gretna. He took his sons on hikes and explored Gettysburg often. He enjoyed fishing with his sons. He was a historian and loved to share history with others.
