Luther H. Garrett, 89, of Lebanon, passed away on Saturday, January 3, 2026, at his home. He was the husband of Elaine M. (Heller) Garrett. On October 10th, they celebrated their 61st wedding anniversary.

Born in Lebanon on March 26, 1936, he was the son of the late Herman and Emma B. (Sattazahn) Garrett. Following high school Luther was drafted into the U.S. Army. After his time serving in the Army, he worked and retired from Cleaver Brooks, where he had worked as a boiler inspector. For over 27 years he served in the PA Air National Guard 193rd Special Operations Wing and retired as a MSgt. He enjoyed working with his hands, hunting, fishing, and being outdoors.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by his children Bryan L. husband of Judith Garrett of Jonestown, Susan E.
