Maria Louise Haniman, 71, of Lebanon, passed away peacefully surrounded by her loving family on May 15, 2015 at her residence. She is survived by her loving husband of 53 years, William Haniman.

Born in Philadelphia, on December 23, 1943, she was the daughter of the late John and Ethel Schaffer Mladjen who resided in Langhorne.
