Marijane Gates, 86, formerly of Lebanon and Harrisburg died Saturday September 24, 2011 in Spang Crest Manor, Lebanon. Born in Lebanon on February 15, 1925, she was the daughter of the late John and Edna Snyder Gates. She was an operator and secretary for Bell of PA and then did clerical work for the Pennsylvania State Fish Commission. She was a 1943 graduate of Lebanon High School, a member of St. Stephen's Episcopal Church, Harrisburg, and a former member of St. Luke's Episcopal Church, Lebanon. Marijane was a violinist in the Harrisburg Symphony Orchestra and was an oil painting artist.
