



Marjorie M. "Marge" Wessner

May 9, 1945 - February 27, 2018

Marjorie M. "Marge" Wessner, 72, of Annville passed away suddenly on Tuesday, February 27, 2018 at The Milton S. Hershey Medical Center. She was the wife of Kermit R. Wessner, with whom she celebrated 50 years of marriage this past December.

Marjorie was born in Reading on May 9, 1945 to the late George and Rachel (Kershner) Kline. She was a graduate of Kutztown University. "Mrs. Wessner" was a beloved elementary school teacher for the Annville-Cleona School District before she retired after teaching for over 25 years and was dedicated to childhood education. She was also a member of the United Church of Christ Church in Annville.

Marjorie enjoyed being outdoors. She loved tending to her garden, taking walks, and visiting the cabins in Sullivan and Potter counties. She especially looked forward to the yearly family trips to the Contrary Club in Canada. Wherever she went, Marjorie was accompanied by her loyal Jack Russell Terriers, Rascal and Boo. She also loved to sew and play Scrabble with family and friends. One of the things Marjorie always looked forward to was spending time with her grandchildren.

In addition to her husband, Kermit, Marjorie is survived by her three daughters, Renee Bezpalko (John R. Reffner) of Chalfont, Nicole Messner (William Paul Messner Jr.) of Cleona, and Kristen Eisenhour (Jason Killian) of Lebanon. She has nine grandchildren, Michael, Tina, Todd, Nicholas, Renata, Peyton, Rilee, Kamyrn, and Kaiden. Marjorie is also survived by her two

sisters, Sara Ann Moyer and Pegeen Kline, both of Hamburg.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, March 3, 2018 at 11AM at the Kreamer Funeral Home, 618 E. Main Street, Annville, PA 17003 with visitation from 9AM until 11AM. A luncheon will follow at Heisey's Diner, 1740 PA-72, Lebanon, PA 17046. The interment will be private.
