Mark G. Ulrich, 79, of Lebanon, passed away on Tuesday, November 29, 2022, at the Lebanon VA Medical Center. He was the husband of Diana L. Schucker.

Born in Lebanon on May 14, 1943, he was the son of the late Paul S. and Hilda E. Flowers Ulrich. From 5th -12th grade, he played the drums in the marching band at Lebanon School District.
